Local restaurants in Buxton

Columbine Restaurant, 7 Hall Bank, Buxton, SK17 6EW 01298 78752

This restaurants serves quite 'posh' food and might be the sort of place to choose if you are celebrating something special. It has been run by the same couple since 1997. They offer an a la carte menu, vegetarian menu and a specials menu. It is a small restaurant in the upper end of town and is on two floors, the ground floor and a cosy cellar.

Flamenco Tapas Bar, 7-9 Concert Place, Buxton, SK17 6EE 01298 27392

A small Spanish restaurant with friendly staff. They have a large menu which is very reasonably priced.

Carriages, Newhaven, Nr. Hartington, Buxton, SK17 0DU 01298 84528

This Sicilian restaurant has a train theme as the name would suggest. Guests eat their meal in one of the two train carriages inside the restaurant, as if on the Orient Express! They consistently have great reviews on Trip Advisor. The restaurant is at Newhaven which is a few miles south of Buxton on the A515.

The Old Hall, The Square, Buxton, SK17 6BD 01298 22841

Reputed to be the oldest hotel in England. The Old Hall Wine Bar serves good pub food in a cosy bar/lounge area. It is open all day for morning coffee, lunch, afternoon tea and evening meals. Open for pre and post theatre dinner. Their a la carte restaurant offers a more formal dining experience, again with pre and post theatre dinners.

Authentic Thai restaurant run by Thai people. It is a large and very popular restaurant with a lively atmosphere.
